





God chose to reveal Himself to us through His Word...

General Revelation

SPECIAL REVELATION

(Scripture)

General Revelation compels me to look for more information.



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

"I believe in the inspiration of the Bible."

INSPIRED — God-breathed

Mechanical inspiration?

Did God take control of the hands or the writers, thus writing His exact words...



But some sections were dictated...

- 10 Commandments
- "Thus says the Lord…"



DUAL AUTHORSHIP...

"The Holy Spirit so superintended the human authors that, through their individual personalities and different styles of writing, they composed and recorded God's Word to man without error in the whole or in the part."

"I believe in the inspiration of the Bible."

But did God inspire the words or the ideas?

"Now the promises were made to Abraham and to his offspring. It does not say, 'And to seeds,' referring to many, but referring to one, 'And to your seed,' who is Christ."

Galatians 3:16

"For truly, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the Law until all is accomplished."

Infallible – totally trustworthy in spiritual matters


Inerrant – totally accurate in all matters (science, history, sociology, psychology)



Confirmation by Jesus

- Jesus quoted extensively from the "scriptures" (Old Testament)
- Jesus referenced OT persons and events as historical
- Jesus used OT as authoritative

"Wait a minute! Was Jesus authoritative?"



BRIEF DETOUR

(Why is Jesus authoritative?)

Evidence for Jesus's Authority

- Jesus fulfilled over 300 prophecies.
- Jesus gave prophecies that were fulfilled.
- Jesus's teachings are effective.
- Jesus worked miracles.
- Jesus rose from the dead.

Jesus validates the apostles' future writing of the New Testament...

"He [the Holy Spirit] will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you."

John 14:26

The Apostles validated not only the Old Testament, but each other's "new" writings...



"Which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, combing spiritual thoughts with spiritual words."

1 Corinthians 2:13

"All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness."

2 Timothy 3:16

"...prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit."

The Bible is consistent with what we would expect from the Romans 1 Creator...

The powerful, intelligent, creative, purposeful, lover-of-beauty we see through nature would likely communicate this way.

The Bible is *efficacious* in my personal life...

The principles given in Scripture work in my life in the real world.

Bible Teachings Are Effective

Principles, wisdom, commandments, and promises work in the real world in real situations.

The Holy Spirit within me confirms the Word of God...

Fulfilled Prophecies

All prophecies that could be fulfilled by present--have been fulfilled.

Internal coherence of the Bible...

Despite varied sources, facts are consistent from book to book.

Undesigned "coincidences"...

Matthew 14 gives private information about what Herod was thinking and saying. How did Matthew know this?

Luke 8 mentions the disciples were followed by Joanna, wife of Chuza (Herod's house manager).

The Bible Is Accurate

Biblical propositions coincide with the real world.

The Bible Is Accurate *HISTORICALLY*


















What about differences among manuscripts?



Dead Sea Scrolls Caves of Qumran (1947)



Dead Sea Scrolls

- over 900 manuscripts
- 300 BC to AD 70
- 30% Hebrew Scripture
- 1000 years earlier than oldest manuscripts


Dead Sea Scrolls indicate that Scripture changed insignificantly over a millennium of copying.



We have access to very many, very reliable early manuscripts of the Bible.





Dynamic Equivalence... Ideas-for-idea translation

- •NIV (New International Version)
- •NLT (New Living Translation)
- •NET (New English Translation)
- •HCSB (Holman Christian Standard Bible)
