


Your framework of basic beliefs.

BIBLICAL view of reality






PHILOSOPHY

- No intrinsic purpose.
- We make our own purpose and meaning to life.
- Only space, time, matter,
 - energy are real.
- No spiritual, supernatural, or soul or after life.

HUMANIST view of reality



PHILOSOPHY

- Only the spiritual is real.
- Spirit brings about the physical.
- Our goal in life is to realize our divine nature and rise to higher levels of enlightenment.
- We share our spiritual essence with all other beings and things.
- We are the universe.
